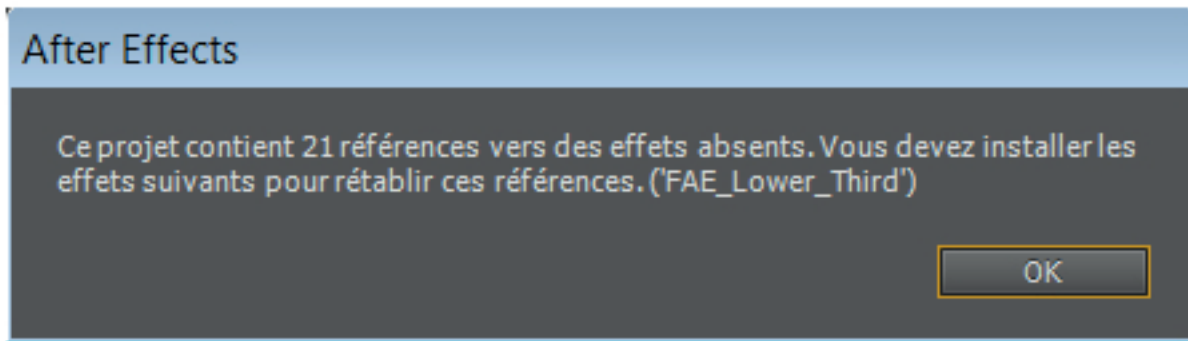


How to install custom effect

If you get this warning when opening the project:

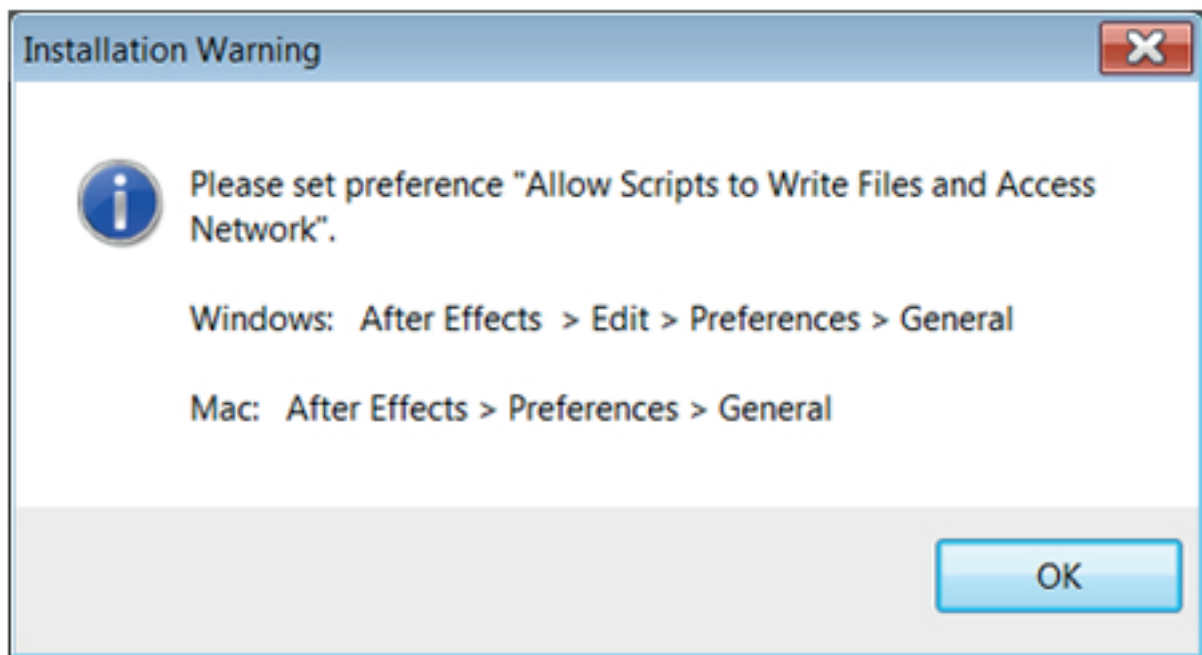


You may need to install the custom effect from this project to remove it.

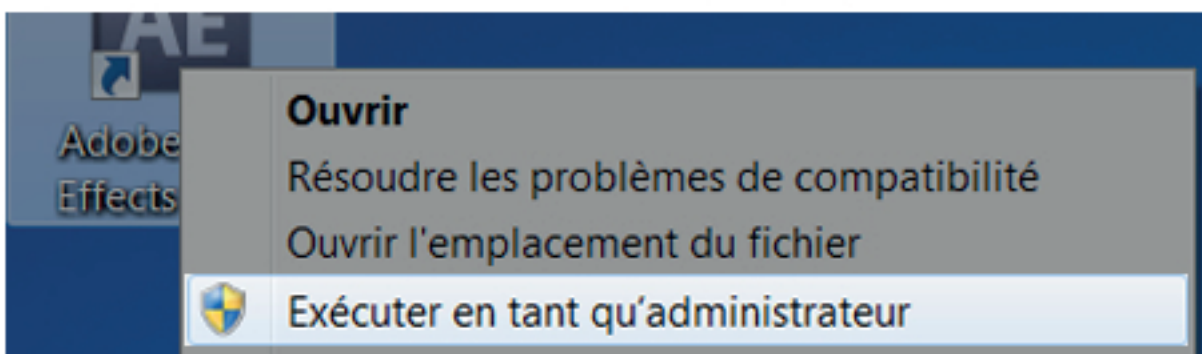
However the project is working perfectly fine without installing the custom effect.

Procedure

1 - First you need to check if the option "**Allow Scripts to Write Files and Access**" is ticked. Otherwise you will get this error when you will try to install the custom effect.

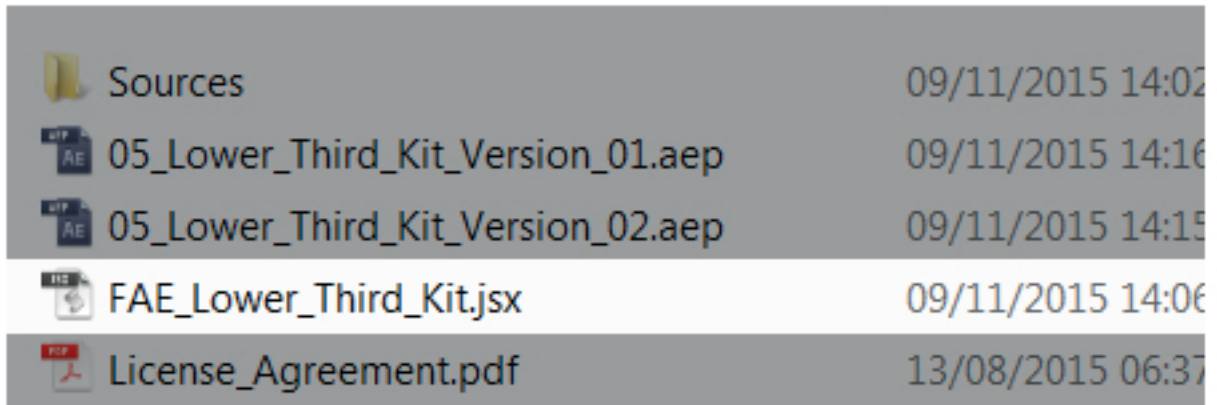


2 - You need to run After Effect in **Administrator Mode** in order to install the custom effect. You need to right click on the application in order to "**Run as administrator**".

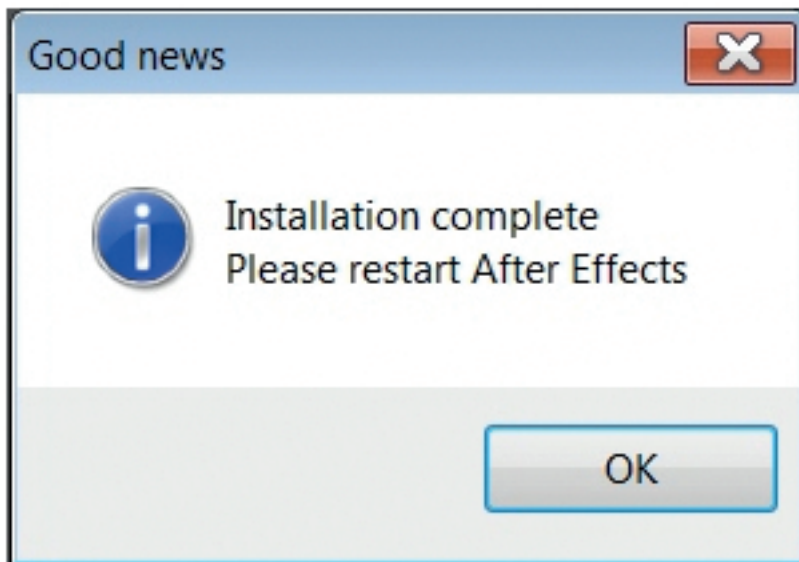


3 - Now you can install the custom effect from the menu:
File -> Scripts -> Run Script File...

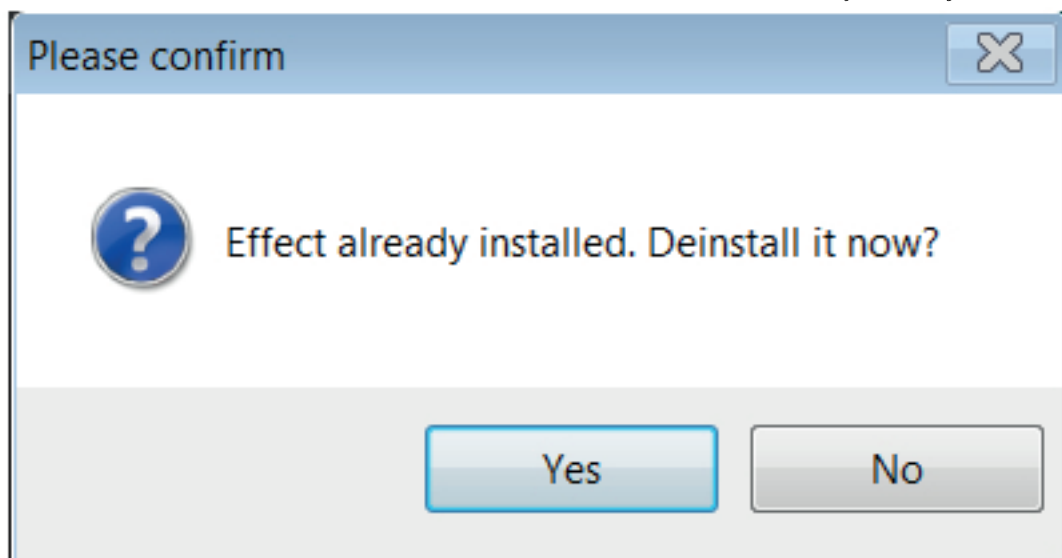
And choose the custom effect "**FAE_Lower_Third_Kit.jsx**" in the project folder:



4 - Once the installation is complete you need to restart After Effects.
You don't need to run it in Administrator Mode.



5 - You can use the project without the warning window when you open the project.
You can uninstall the custom effect with the same way and just choose **Yes:**

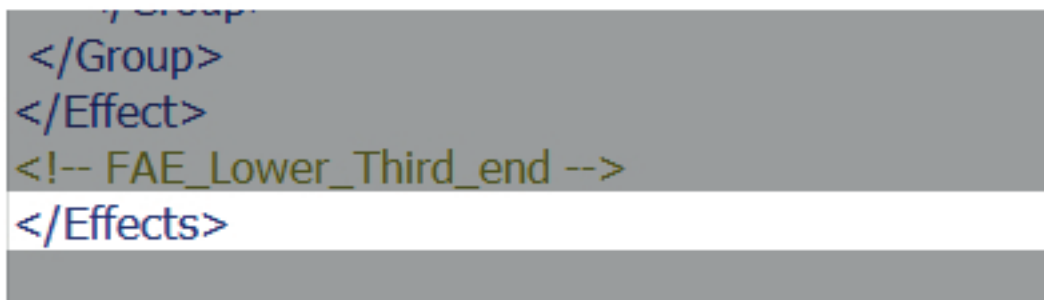


6 - If you cannot install the custom effect this way, you will have to do it manually. You need to locate the file "**PresetEffects.xml**" and modify it with any text editor:

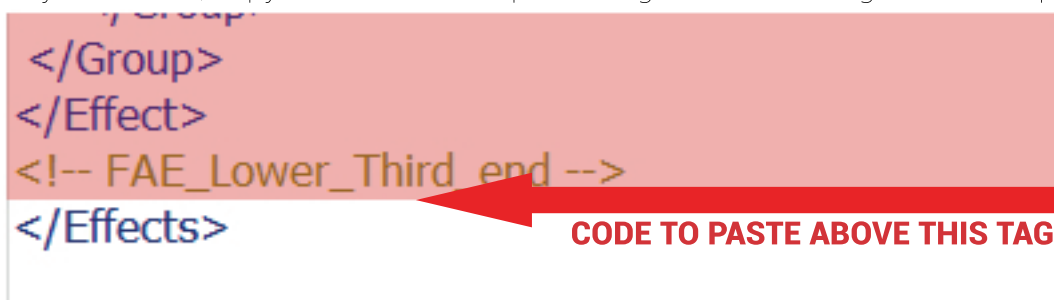
- For **Mac** Users: /Applications/Adobe After Effects CSx/ (Show Package Contents) /Resources/PresetEffects.xml
- For **Windows** Users: C:\Program Files\Adobe\Adobe After Effects CSx\Support Files\PresetEffects.xml



7 - Scroll down until you find the last line which is the tag: **</Effects>**:



8 - Open the file in the project folder ""Sources/Script/**FAE_Lower_Third_Kit_CE**"" in any text editor, copy all the code and paste it right above the tag mentioned previously:



Save the file and close it. Finally restart After Effects and you can use the project without the warning message.

9 -To uninstall the custom effect simply delete the code from the file:
PresetEffects.xml.
